### Agenda Topics

Call to Order	The meeting was called to order at 11:40am.
Public Comment	There was no public comment.
Review of Agenda & Approval of Minutes	Introductions were done around the room. The April 4 <sup>th</sup> Community Advisory Council (CAC) meeting minutes were reviewed and approved.
Group Guidelines and Purpose Statement	The CAC guidelines and purpose statement were read aloud.
Oregon Acute Pain Prescribing Guidelines	<p>Oregon has made significant changes in the prescribing guidelines for opioids. Prior to the April 25<sup>th</sup> CAC meeting, a CAC member approached Dr. Jeanne Savage with concerns about the opioid guidelines for providers. In response, Dr. Savage invited the member to voice his concerns at the meeting so that she could provide the council with more information on the guidelines.</p> <p>The CAC member raised concerns regarding the prescribing of opioids or lack thereof and whether or not providers were aware of the guidelines. There was also concern that WVCH members may not be getting treated appropriately for their pain needs.</p> <p>WVCH has recommended and followed the recommendations of the CDC and the state of Oregon. These guidelines are what providers follow in order to help patients be safe, and to help address the opioid epidemic that Oregon is facing. Dr. Savage shared some of the questions that the guidelines recommend asking when patients are in pain. Addiction and overuse can happen within 3 days of using opioids.</p>
Partner Presentation	The Law Enforcement Assisted Diversion (LEAD) team introduced themselves. Jan Calvin, a contractor with Marion County managing the implementation of LEAD, provided background and information on the project. LEAD partners with law enforcement to support low level offenders who choose to opt into the program to receive assistance. The focus of the program is harm reduction and crime

	<p>reduction. LEAD navigators work with individuals to connect them with community resources and supports. The navigators will also attend appointments with individuals who prefer to not go alone. The LEAD program currently assists 25-30 people. All of the individuals who receive LEAD assistance get enrolled in OHP if they enter the program without health insurance.</p>
2019 CAC Meeting Schedule	<p>The WVCH CAC is required to meet quarterly by the Oregon Health Authority. Teri Alexander and Jeanne Savage asked for feedback from the CAC on topics for future CAC meetings. It was determined that there would be a CAC meeting in June and that the next meeting will likely be in September.</p> <p>Jeanne will provide contact information for the ombudsman and will look into other opportunities for CAC members to get involved in the health of their community.</p>
Word on the Street	<p>MCHHS sent out about 72 partner surveys about health equity and have only received 2 back. If you were one of those partners please fill it out and return it.</p> <p>Interface Network is having a health insurance enrollment fair on May 18<sup>th</sup> at the Goodwill on Lancaster from 9am-3pm.</p> <p><b>Correction:</b> CAC stipends are only available to WVCH members who attend a CAC meeting. The meeting must take place in order to receive a stipend for the month.</p>
